

## **Punjab government is making un-tired efforts to improve the law and order.**

Punjab government is making un-tired efforts to improve the law and order situation in the province. The government wants to give special training to police force to tackle the menace of terrorism. He asked the business community to help the government in improving law and order situation. This was stated by the Punjab Chief Minister Senior Advisor Sardar Zulfiqar Ali Khosa while speaking an important meeting of Punjab Chambers of Commerce & Industry Coordination Committee at Lahore Chamber of Commerce & Industry here on Saturday. Chief Minister Senior Advisor on Political Affairs Muhammad Pervez Malik, the LCCI President Zafar Iqbal Chaudhry, Vice President Faisal Iqbal Sheikh, office-bearers of Punjab Chambers of Commerce & Industry and a large number of representatives of government departments were also present on the occasion. Sardar Zulfiqar Ali Khosa said that the government is doing all possible effort to provide better security at education institutions. Furthermore, He said that business community had played an appreciable role for the help of IDPs. He said that help extended by the businessmen provided enough relief to the refugees.
